THE COURT: If I come to a different conclusion and rule that the S.P.C.A. had an obligation in these circumstances where the animal is not in critical distress, but merely is in distress in their view; in other words, is thin, not being properly nourished, and some steps had to be taken in order to relieve its distress, and if I find that they make the common having they made no attempt to contact the owner, having an obligation to do so, and the owner was not in a position where they could not be found immediately since they had her name and address 12 and phone number and contacts in their file, if I 13 then find that the warrant is not valid, do you have any submission as to their remedy? Is it a breach of a Charter itself? If it's an unreasonable search which, if it's obtained -- if the search is done without a valid warrant, it would prima facie be unreasonable, what would you say about either the counsel's suggestion that I should therefore enter a stay or, conversely, that I should exclude all evidence following that point or some other remedy?

(SUBMISSIONS BY COUNSEL)

THE CCURT: Okay. We're going to take the afternoon adjournment to consider my position and we'll resume as quickly as I can.

(PROCEEDINGS ADJOURNED) (PROCEEDINGS RECONVENED)

THE COURT: We are dealing in the case at bar with a charge against Ann Brown, alleging that between the 21st of November, '98 and the 19th of March, 1999, in Langley, she caused or permitted animals, mamely horses, to be or continue to be in distress, contrary to Section 24 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act.
