briefly summarize the facts. As a result of a complaint, Constable Robertson attends an address, 25363 24th Avenua in Langley, British Columbia, to look for apparently emaciated horses. There was reporte of thin horses. Apparently, he observed some thin horses on that date and there was a return to that property two days later on the 19th of March at which time two S.P.C.A. officers examined two of the horses closely and gave them a rating, sort of a body condition rating, that was Constable Robertson and Echols, and they scored two of these horses at the low end of the range, one being a 1.5 and the other being a 1.8. The opinion of the officers were that the horses were in distress. Special Constable Robertson said at the time that he know the owner to be Ann Brown. He said, "I didn't know how to reach her." But it is clear, from the evidence of both of the S.P.C.A. officers that they did know how to reach her. They had her telephone number. Later on in fact, in cross-examination, Constable Robertson says he never told the Justics of the Peace that he knew the owner and had her phone number and he never made any attempt to phone her. Nobody made any attempt to go to her residence and not only did they not do that, but they neglected to tell the Justice of the Peace in the Information to Obtain that they had that information. That becomes important and really, with respect to the facts in the search warrant, that is about all I have to summarize, except to say that armed with that information, instead of contacting the owner to give the owner an opportunity to relieve the distress in the animals, the officers went to a Justice of the Peace under Section 13 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act and sought and obtained a
