the Justice of the Peace issues the search warrant. They then use the search warrant to seize, I believe, nine horses, a number of horses, in any event. Some later die, but 5 ε 7 the issue is, with respect to the search warrant, did they comply with the prerequisites for ξ obtaining a search warrant? The Crown concedes that the prerequisites 11 for obtaining a search warrant are contained in 12 Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to 13 Animals Act. It is only after dealing with that 14 section that an agent, namely an S.P.C.A. agent, 15 may then go and apply for a warrant under Sections 13 and 14 of the Act. As I said, the 16 17 prerequisite is required that they do those 18 things and without them, they cannot move on to 19 Section 13 and 14. 20 Section 11 reads, briefly: 21 22 "If an authorized agent is of the opinion 23 that an animal is in distress and that the 24 person responsible for the animal a) does not properly take steps that will relieve 25 its distress or b) cannot be found 25 27 immediately and informed of the animal's 28 distress, the authorized agent may, in 29 accordance with Sections 13 and 14, take any OE action that the authorized agent considers 31 necessary to relieve the animal's distress 32 including, without limitation, taking custody of the animal and arranging for 33 34 food, water, shelter and veterinary 35 treatment for it." 36 37 I have no doubt here that the officers felt 38 that these animals, or some of them at least, 39 were in distress, in distress to the extent that they felt they were not being properly nourished 40 41 and that they were extremely thin and, in one or 42 two cases, in some state of emaciation. 43 The issue, as I see it, is whether or not they were required under the Act to make some attempt to contact the owner.
