AGREEMENT (the "Agreement")

BETWEEN:

OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS (the "Society")**

**Re: Removal of 7 canines by the Society from 41759 Lougheed Highway,
Deroche, B.C. on January 11, 2005, pursuant to the *Prevention of Cruelty to
Animals Act* R.S.B.C. 1996, c372 (the "Act") and a Warrant to Search issued
on January 10, 2005**

WHEREAS:

- A. The Society and Animal Owner wish to conclude an agreement for the return of the Animals to the custody of the Animal Owner

THE SOCIETY AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

- B. It will transfer the Animals from the custody of the Society to the custody of the Animal Owner upon satisfaction of an inspection of the facilities where the animals will be kept and the conditions below

THE ANIMAL OWNER AGREES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Prior to any transfer of the Animals by the Society from the custody of the Society to the custody of the Animal Owner, the Society can inspect the property where the Animals will be kept after their proposed return to the custody of the Animal Owner (the "Property"), and the conditions thereon, and the Society must approve the conditions on the Property prior to any transfer of the Animals by the Society to the custody of the Animal Owner.
 2. Prior to any return of the Animals by the Society to the custody of the Animal Owner, the Animal Owner will pay the costs of care incurred by the Society.
 3. Provide the Society with access to the Property, upon 24 hours' notice of the Society's intention to visit the Property, in order to permit the Society to conduct inspections of the Property and the Animals, and to co-operate with the Society's visit.
 4. The Animal Owner, and or another person responsible for the Animals, will attend to the Animals, on a daily basis, for the purposes of ensuring the health and well being of all of the Animals.
 5. To provide clean, potable drinking water for the Animals, at all times.
 6. To ensure that the Animals have access to adequate food, at all times.
 7. To ensure all waste material be disposed of in an appropriate fashion.
 8. To provide shelter adequate to protect the Animals from adverse weather conditions.
 9. To establish a parasite control program, approved by a registered veterinarian, for the benefit of the Animals.
 10. To ensure a licensed Veterinarian examine the Animals annually and to forward a copy of the examinations to the Cruelty Investigations Department.
 11. Not to increase the numbers of Animals in his possession.
 12. To ensure that the Animals are not chained for long periods.
 13. To provide the Animals with dry warm bedding at all times.
 14. To ensure the Animals avoid situations that promote fighting.
 15. To notify the Society and to get approval of same if any of the dogs are to be moved, sold or transferred.
 16. To ensure all veterinarian recommendations are followed.
